## Entry Fees

A Temporary Competition fee (**\$10.50**) and Temporary Competition number (TCN), as established by The Canadian Kennel Club, **must accompany the entry** of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. **Attention Foreign Exhibitors** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry, and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable to **Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club** in Canadian funds.

### Entry

- Entries will be accepted by mail, hand delivery or email.
- All **email** entries must have the entry form scanned and sent as an attachment to the test secretary at [cehall@shaw.ca](mailto:cehall@shaw.ca)
- **\*\* Include your UTD-Pretest certificate with your entry, if applicable\*\***
- **CKC Rule 6.3.2 (I) ALL CKC tracking titles earned by the dog MUST be included on the entry form. Failure to do so may result in a test pass being cancelled.**
- Entrants will be notified by email or phone when their entry **with payment** has been received by the test secretary. If you have not heard from the test secretary within 48 hours of an electronic submission, or a reasonable amount of time for mail submission, contact the test secretary to confirm receipt of entry.
- Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, regardless of who completes the entry form.
- **CKC Rule 6.6.4** Once a dog has qualified for a UTD or UTDX title **after** entering this test, the entrant is to promptly advise the test secretary who will adjust the entry draw to reflect the dog's change in title status.
- Incomplete or improper entry forms will not be accepted.
- Entries received after closing date and time will be discarded.
- Bitches in season may compete. Bitches in season will be assigned the last track(s). Please advise the test secretary immediately upon arrival at the meeting place, or earlier if possible.

### Payments

- Cheques/money orders payable to **Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club** **MUST** accompany all mailed entries.
- No post-dated cheques will be accepted.
- Tendering of a dishonoured cheque in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards by the Canadian Kennel Club. A collection fee of \$25 will be added to any returned cheque.
- E-transfer to [FPOTCPAYMENT@GMAIL.COM](mailto:FPOTCPAYMENT@GMAIL.COM) for emailed entries. E-transfers are auto-deposited
- **N.B. The e-transfer deposit confirmation reference # **MUST** be included with the emailed entry.**

### Draw for Entry

- A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine placement in the test or on an alternate list.
- **The drawing will be at 5pm on Tuesday, April 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at the test secretary's residence, 611 South McPhedran Rd, Campbell River, BC**
- Exhibitors will be notified within 24 hours of draw completion.
- Club worker draw (per CKC 6.6.2) will be utilized if eligible entries are received from club workers as defined by the FPOTC tracking committee.
- FPOTC will use the following procedures for the draw:
  - o FPOTC Worker
  - o Purebred dogs without a title
  - o Purebred dogs with a title
  - o Mixed breed and unrecognized breeds without a title
  - o Mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds with a title

- Any primary entrant(s) who is absent at this time will forfeit their position to the first Alternate present.

## AWARDS & NO-HOST LUNCHEON:

- A Ribbon and an Award will be given to all passing teams
- There may be a no host lunch held after the test to de-brief tracks and hand out awards. Location TBA

## REFUNDS:

- If an entrant or an alternate who accepts a position in the test pulls out after the closing date, and there are no additional alternates willing to accept the position, the entry fee is forfeited to the club.
- If an entrant pulls out of the test and their position is filled by an alternate who accepts the position, the alternate is now responsible for the entry fee paid to the club. The original entrant will be refunded in full.
- Entries will be refunded within 10 days of the tracking test to those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test.

## GENERAL

- **Rule 14.7:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
- **Limitation of Liability:** In attending this test, competitors, spectators, and guests acknowledge they do so at their own risk and that of any dog. They also agree, upon submitting an entry form, that they will not hold liable the CKC, the FPOTC or its officials, the Judge or the landowner(s) for any loss, damage, or injury, however arising, to themselves, their dog(s) or any other chattels.
- **CKC Rule 10.1.8 Exhibitors may not train on the tracking fields (this includes urban areas designated for an urban test) within 10 days of the test. The Test Secretary\* will advise accepted test entrants of the location(s) of the designated test areas. This includes a judge holding a workshop/seminar on the tracking test site (field or urban) within 10 days of the test.**
- \*Test entrants to contact the secretary to ask if a desired area is available for training within the 10 days.
- Regarding communicable diseases, please see rule 6.8 in the current CKC Tracking Test Rules and Regulations.
- **CKC Rule 2.6.1** All persons must exercise care and control of any dog in their possession while attending an event. They should endeavour to keep their dogs on lead at all times while in the area of and on the tracking sites
- A marshal will be assigned at each location, and the gallery will be required to follow the marshal's instructions regarding following a dog on track.

Non-Member Participation Fee [Board Motion #24-12-10]

- (a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of The Canadian Kennel Club. [Board Motion #98-03-22]
- (b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a Canadian Kennel Club member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within thirty (30) days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- (c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-Canadian Kennel Club members and are not applicable to Canadian Kennel Club members.
